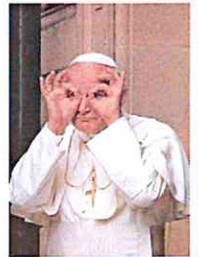
What does Church Law say about sponsors?

- A Candidate for Baptism should be given a sponsor also known as a God parents (Can. 872)
- Ordinarily only 1 male or 1 female or one of each sex is to be employed. (Can. 873)
- A sponsor must be at least 16 years of age, be a Confirmed Catholic, made 1st Holy Communion & leads a life in harmony with the Faith and the role to be undertaken. They must have the intention of performing this role (Can. 874, 2& 3)
- The parents of the child may not assume the role of sponsor. (Can 874.5)

What is Baptism & Christening all about?

This leaflet puts before you the main considerations which you as parents will have in mind when you request Baptism for your child in the Catholic Church. Baptism and Christening (one ceremony) is the most significant moment in our lives. As a thing of infinite value you must weigh carefully your intentions and commitment with regard to all that this great gift implies.

What does Church Law say about preparation for Baptism?

The parents and sponsors are to be properly instructed in the meaning of this Sacrament and the obligation attached to it.
 (Can. 851.2)

Baptisms at the Good Shepherd Church take place on Saturdays at 12 noon or Sundays at 1.00 p.m.
 Other times by prior arrangement with the Parish Priest.
 A Seminar of Preparation is held regularly; usually every second month beginning in January - see inside for dates.

Seminars are at 3.00 p.m. in the Marian Hall and last for about one hour approximately.
