

**MESSAGE FROM
THE WORLD APOSTOLATE OF FATIMA—ENGLAND & WALES**

The devotion to Our Lady's Immaculate Heart is strongly emphasised in the Fatima message. During the 13 June 1917 apparition, the Blessed Virgin said to Lucia, "Jesus wants to use you to make me known and loved. He wishes to establish the devotion to my Immaculate Heart throughout the world. I promise salvation to whoever embraces it; these souls will be dear to God, like flowers put by Me to adorn his throne." She also promised Lucia that her Immaculate Heart would be her refuge and the way that would lead her to God."



WAF-E&W hope that the CPVS-IHM will visit many religious houses, convents, and parishes to promote the Communion of Reparation on the first Saturdays, with the Relics of Saints Jacinta and Francisco and become an instrument to provide the catechesis of the Sorrowful and Immaculate Heart of Mary, surrounded with thorns and needing reparation.

The First Saturday Devotion of Reparation signifies the intimate union of the hearts of Jesus and Mary. In this devotion, Jesus himself desires reparation for the sins which pierce His Mother's sorrowful heart, the maternal symbol of her merciful love and desire for the salvation of all mankind in Him.

The reliquary contains particles of the original coffins of Saints Jacinta and Francisco Marto.

Five First Saturdays

The Five First Saturdays devotion, first revealed by Our Lady at Fatima on 13 July 1917, was requested on 10 December 1925, when the Blessed Virgin, appeared again to Sr. Lucia, together with the Child Jesus, who said:

“Have compassion on the heart of your most Holy Mother”



- **What is required for the Devotion?**
Each part of the devotion should be made with the intention of making reparation to the Immaculate Heart of Mary, on the first Saturday of five consecutive months.
- Go to confession – this can be up to 8 days before or after the First Saturday itself.
- Receive Holy Communion - on the day itself, in a state of grace, with the intention of making reparation as above.
- Recite five decades of the Rosary.
- Meditate on the mysteries of the Rosary for 15 minutes: this is not difficult, e.g, slowly read the Gospel account of the mysteries, or use a booklet on the Rosary.
