RELICS OF ST. ANDREW (Apostle), ST. MARGARET OF SCOTLAND & ST. COLUMBA: The relics of three Scottish Saints will be visiting the Good Shepherd on 2nd and 3rd July 2025. The reliquary will arrive on 2nd July and there will be a short welcome liturgy prior to morning mass. Following mass, we are invited to visit for veneration and then from 2.00-4.00pm and 6.00pm-7.00pm. On 3rd July, veneration will take place after morning mass and at 2.00pm-4.00pm and 6.00pm-7.00pm prior to the relics departing the Good Shepherd with a short liturgy. The visit has been arranged by the Knights of St Columba in celebration of the Jubilee Year of Hope. See the accompanying leaflet for more details.
