
SAINT JOSEPH AT FATIMA

SAINT JOSEPH PILLAR OF FAMILIES

As we can see from his titles above, Saint Joseph as well as being the Head of the Holy Family, is also the Pillar of Families and Head of the Holy Church.

His appearance at Fatima reminds us of his exalted role. In each of her apparitions at Fatima, Our Lady asked us to pray the daily Rosary. Saint Joseph plays an essential part in each of the Joyful Mysteries of the Rosary, as he lived those mysteries with Jesus and Mary. He prayed with them, he listened to and spoke with them daily, he protected them and he raised Jesus as his son. As Head of the Holy Family, Saint Joseph played a strong role. Saint Peter Julian Eymard said:

"Jesus and Mary not only bent their wills to Joseph's, for he was head of the Holy Family, but they lovingly surrendered their hearts to him as well"

In his book "Consecration to St Joseph" Fr Donald Calloway MIC points out that in our current times, it is not politically correct to call a man "head" of the family and he talks about a "crisis in manhood" which he says is having a profound effect on families and society. Fr Calloway states that this can be corrected if men begin to model themselves on the strong, fatherly example which St Joseph provides for God has designated fathers as the heads of their families.

This is echoed by Monseignor Joseph Cirrincione In his book "St Joseph, Fatherhood and Fatherhood: Reflections on the Miracle of the Sun", where he talks about the convulsions of the sun following the apparition of the Holy Family in Fatima in October 1917 as "an ominous foreshadowing of the consequences for the world which are sure to be felt if the true fatherhood of God and the traditional, strong role of the father of the family are rejected by mankind."

At Fatima, Our Lady warned of the "errors of Russia" and the need for conversion. At that time, the communists were spreading their anti-God ideology in many places during the 20th century and fatherhood and God were not part of their atheistic agenda. By the 21st century, the family being the target of attacks, began to collapse and to be dismantled. Our Lady warned that the "final battle will be about the family" and St Joseph appeared at Fatima to remind us of the strength fathers and families need. Fr Calloway states "Families around the world will experience a revolution of holiness if husbands imitate St Joseph" Fr Calloway asks that we make a consecration to St Joseph in this year dedicated by Pope Francis as the "Year of St Joseph". He asks that we make St Joseph the spiritual head of our families and that we place an image or a statue of St Joseph in a prominent location where we can ask for his intercession as a family.

PRAYER TO ST JOSEPH OVER 1900 YEARS OLD


